



Rawlinsville Camp Meeting Children’s Ministry Information for Parents

Leadership and Contact Information

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Programs

Nursery (10am Bible Study (M-F); Saturday morning service (if one is held); Sunday morning worship service) – ages 1 to 3 (not potty trained). Infants under the age of 1 should remain with caregivers.

Preschool (10 a.m. Bible study (M-F); Sunday morning worship service; evening service). Children age 3 (potty trained) through 5 (haven’t been to Kindergarten yet).

RCM Kids (10 a.m. Bible study (M-F); Sunday morning worship service; evening service). Children who have completed Kindergarten through completed 4th grade.

RCM Kids Crafts (in the Children’s Tabernacle; 1:30 p.m. week days for children who have completed Kindergarten and 1st grade; 2:30 p.m. week days for children who have completed 2nd to 4th grade.

56 (Completed 5th and 6th grade). Meets morning, afternoon, and evening (please pick up a schedule for more information).

Please note: Children must have adult supervision at all times while they are on the grounds, and they are expected to participate in scheduled programming during adult Bible studies and worship services.

Information and Procedures

Nursery Age:

- The Nursery is located in Cabin 43. An unstaffed mothers' room is located in the rear of the office.
- Nursery staff will greet you and help you sign your child in.
- Parent(s)/Guardian(s) will be given a Nursery ID Tag on a bracelet. This matches the Nursery ID tag that is on your child and your child's diaper bag.
- Please keep your cell phone handy and on vibrate, as it will be used to inform you if you are needed in the nursery.
- Please have all of your child's belongings clearly labeled with his/her name
- Please notify the nursery staff if your child has special needs or allergies.
- Following Bible study and/or the worship service, children may be picked up by the parent/guardian who has the Nursery ID tag that matches the child. Nursery workers will not release a child if the Nursery ID tags do not match.
- Please pick up your child promptly after the service.

Preschool

- Our pre-school program is located above the Boarding House.
- Parents should complete a registration form with \$15 registration fee.
- Parents should walk students up the outside steps to enter and exit using the inside steps.
- Preschoolers should use the bathroom prior to all services to help cut down the number of trips to the bathroom. Participants must be potty trained.
- Please notify the staff if your child has special needs or allergies.
- Please make sure preschool staff have your cell phone number and keep your cell phone handy and on vibrate in case preschool staff needs to contact you.
- Following the Bible study or worship service, parents are encouraged to promptly pick up their children from the preschool class.

RCM Kids:

- Our completed Kindergarten through completed 4th grade program is located in the Children's Building, up the hill from the Main Tabernacle.
- After completing the registration form and submitting the \$15 fee, students may come to services on their own.
- Students should use the bathroom prior to coming to the service.
- Shoes should be worn to all services.
- No toys or candy should be brought to the services.

- Children will be dismissed at the conclusion of the adult service. **Only upon request** are teachers/helpers to wait on releasing children.

56 Ministry

- Students who have completed 5th and 6th grade meet in the Brett Hershey Tabernacle on the hill above the Boarding House.
- Parents should fill out a registration form and pay the appropriate fee per student.
- 56 students participate in some activities with the youth age students.
- 56 students come and go from services on their own.

Illness & Allergy Guidelines and Procedures

Illness:

For the health and safety of all our children, staff, and the peace of mind of parents/ guardians, children that have the following symptoms within the last 24hrs should not be placed in any camp ministry:

- **Fever of 100.0 or over in the last 24 hours.**
- **Diarrhea**
- **Vomiting**
- **Yeast infection, thrush**
- **Infected wounds, boils, untreated ringworm**
- **Runny nose with green or yellow discharge**
- **Communicable eye infections, conjunctivitis (pink eye)**
- **Contagious untreated skin rash**
- **Cough, croup (except allergy)**
- **Any symptom of usual childhood disease such as mumps, measles, chicken pox**
- **Head lice**
- **Use of antibiotics less than 24hrs**

Medication Policy

Parents must be responsible for any medications needed by any student.
