What is RCM Kids?

- RCM Kids is a safe and structured program designed for our camp kids. They will enjoy singing, Bible stories, crafts, and other related activities in the morning, afternoon, and evening.
- **Registration fee:** \$20 for one week or \$30 for two weeks to register for RCM Kids and Preschool. There is a \$5 discount for multiple children. There is no daily rate. Please submit this fee with the registration form to a staff member or online.
- If anyone in your family is showing symptoms of any kind, we are asking for you to please stay home, not just in your cabin.

RCM Kids (*Completed K-4th Grades*)

- Register each child enrolled in the RCM Kids or Preschool Program. Please speak to a staff member regarding any allergies.
- **A responsible adult should be on the grounds at all times in case of an emergency.**
- **While on the grounds, children, youth, and adults are expected to attend services provided.**
- Children should report to their service promptly after the camp bell rings.
- **No food, drink, candy, or toys** should be brought to programs.
- Children are expected to remain with the group for the entire program. (**Remember to use the bathroom before coming.**)
- At the end of the service, children will be dismissed on their own. *Unless otherwise requested.*
- Parents of children who are not staying on the campgrounds should meet their children **promptly** after the conclusion of the service. **Please notify staff if you are doing this.**
- Children are encouraged to memorize the memory verses for a prize.

RCM Preschool (*Not yet attended Kindergarten*)

- Parents of preschoolers should escort their children to and from the Preschool Room on the 2nd floor of the Children's Building.
- Preschoolers should be picked up **promptly** at the conclusion of each service. If you find that you are going to be detained, please make arrangements for your child to be picked up by another person (Must be a teen or adult), who is listed on the Registration Form as an Alternate Pick-up.
- No food, drink, candy, or toys should be brought to the programs.
