What is RCM Kids?

RCM Kids is a safe and structured program designed for our camp kids. They will enjoy singing, Bible stories, crafts, and other related activities in the morning, afternoon and evenings.

Registration Fee: \$20 for one week or \$30 for two weeks for Preschool and Kids Programs. There is a \$5 discount for multiple children. There is NO daily rate. Please submit this fee with the registration form in person or online (closes Sunday, July 28th)

If anyone in your family is showing symptoms of illness, we ask that you please stay home.

RCM Kids (Completed K-4th Grades)

- Register each child to be enrolled in the preschool or Kids Program.
- A responsible adult should be on the grounds at all times in case of an emergency.
- While on the grounds, children, youth and adults are expected to attend services.
- Children should report to their service promptly after the camp bell rings. Please wear shoes!
- No food, drink, candy or toys should be brought to the programs.
- Children are expected to remain with the group for the entire program. Remember to use the bathroom prior to lining up.
- At the end of the service, KIDS will be dismissed on their own. *Parents may request that we hold KIDS to be picked up by an adult.*
- Parents of children who are not staying on the campground should meet their children promptly after the conclusion of the service. Please notify staff if you are doing this.
- Children are encouraged to memorize the memory verse for a prize.
- We will text if you are needed during the service.
